Chapter-1 → Nouns

Definition → A noun is the name of a person, animal, place or thing.

example - Ritu is a good girl.

→ Common Nouns and Proper Nouns

\* A noun that gives a common name to persons, animals, places or things is called a common noun.

example - boy, city, river, etc.

\* A noun that gives a special name to a particular person, animal, place or thing is called a proper noun.

example - Ashish, Shillong, Yamuna, etc.

\* A proper noun always begins with a capital letter.

→ Singular (one) or plural (more than one)

\* A noun standing for one person, animal, place or thing is said to be in the singular number.

example - ball, lion, bench, knife, story etc

\* A noun standing for more than one person, animal, place or thing is said to be in the plural number.

example - balls, lions, benches, knives, stories
